

The God of the people of Israel chose our ancestors; he made the people prosper during their stay in **Egypt**; with mighty power he led them out of that country;¹⁸ for about forty years he endured their conduct in **the wilderness**;¹⁹ and he overthrew seven nations in Canaan, **giving their land** to his people as their inheritance.²⁰ All this took about 450 years.

“After this, God gave them **judges** until the time of **Samuel** the prophet.²¹ Then the people asked for a king, and he gave them **Saul** son of Kish, of the tribe of Benjamin, who ruled forty years.²² After removing Saul, he made **David** **their king**. God testified concerning him: ‘I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do.’”

Before the coming of Jesus, **John** preached repentance and baptism to all the people of Israel.²⁵ As John was completing his work, he said: ‘Who do you suppose I am? I am not the one you are looking for. But there is one coming after me whose sandals I am not worthy to untie.’

²⁷ The people of Jerusalem and their rulers **did not recognize Jesus, yet in condemning him they fulfilled the words of the prophets** that are read every Sabbath. ²⁸ Though they found no proper ground for a death sentence, they asked Pilate to have him **executed**. ²⁹ When they had **carried out all that was written about him**, they took him down from the cross and laid him in a tomb.

But God raised him from the dead,³¹ and for many days he was seen by those who had traveled with him from Galilee to Jerusalem. They are now his witnesses to our people.

As Paul and Barnabas were leaving the synagogue, the people invited them to speak further about these things on the next Sabbath.⁴³ When the congregation was dismissed, many of the Jews and devout converts to Judaism followed Paul and Barnabas, who talked with them and urged them to continue in the grace of God.

⁴⁴ On the next Sabbath almost the whole city gathered to hear the word of the Lord. ⁴⁵ When the Jews saw the crowds, they were filled with jealousy. They began to contradict what Paul was saying and heaped abuse on him.

Then Paul and Barnabas answered them boldly: “We had to speak the word of God to you first. Since you reject it and do not consider yourselves worthy of eternal life, **we now turn to the Gentiles.** ⁴⁷ **For this is what the Lord has commanded us:**

“I have made you a light for the Gentiles,
that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth.”

⁴⁸ When the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and honored the word of the Lord; and all who were appointed for eternal life believed.




