The Gospels quote verse 4 in reference to John the Baptist preparing the way for Jesus. What does that imply about the identity of Jesus? How can you prepare the way in your life for Jesus?

Jesus comes as Shepherd (v. 11) as well as King. How are you experiencing Jesus as Shepherd and King?
